Staffing Update

Teachers and Leaders

- Panels for 16 permanent teaches have been completed. These are currently in an appeal process. We are hoping to announce the outcomes by the end of this term.

Alex Hoffmann who has won the Years 9 and 10 Leader for the next 5 years. She will be continuing in the role she has undertaken for the last 2 years.

Curriculum and Non-curriculum SSOs

The Business Manager is developing a draft budget for 2022 to take to the Personnel Advisory Committee (PAC) to look at funds available and how to use these funds for 2022 and then 2023 (note we will need to consider the impact of the double cohort year in 2022). We are also considering what jobs require additional support for 2021.

Curriculum Planning and Student Learning

This was the focus of the Week 8 Pupil Free Day. As I walked around and talked with each faculty in the afternoon and heard about their progress, each learning area is at a different stage in readiness for Year 7 students. All faculties are looking at how they will embed the site improvement focus of literacy (technical/Tier 3 vocabulary and writing tasks) for the Year 7s. So much progress was made on the day. Weeks 4 and 7 of terms 2 and 3 - primary school teachers are joining secondary teachers in faculty areas.

Facilities Planning

Key points:

Hospitality Centre

- Painting internal and external walls
- Flooring next week, followed by installation of stainless steel

Multipurpose Building

- Brickwork is progressing quickly
- External cladding
- First fix services followed by aluminium windows and doors
- Trying to get to lock up stage

Tech Studies

- Ceilings, painting, joinery and stormwater to happen over next couple of weeks

Completion date still is November 15th.

Quad Buildings x 2

- These buildings have gone to tender, which closes July 19th.
- Buildings 15 and 34 are being replaced by the new quad buildings. These old buildings are being demolished during the school holidays.
- The new buildings are due to arrive by the end of October.

New Dual Disability Unit

- This will now arrive in October
- Site work for this building will begin during the school holidays.

Home Ec Upgrade

- No update as the architect who was doing the drawings had a medical condition

School Community - Teams Meetings have been happening with the Year 6 and 7 students from our feeder schools and the students from our school.

Outcomes from Governing Council relevant to Years 6 and 7

- A discussion about unbudgeted items to establish the classrooms for next year resulted in agreement on a Phase 1 and 2 approach, due to the cost of \$687,000 to the school. We will proceed with the phase 1 and monitor the Phase 2 purchases as the building projects continue.
- The discussion re traffic concerns at the front of the school resulted in the following agreements:
further follow up with Stephan Knoll and Ashton Hurn
look at Risk Assessment associated with the traffic
can we get a traffic engineer's report?
- The introduction of QKr! App for school was approved. This will be used in the school and the canteen. We will begin with using it in the canteen.
